

To initiate or participate in a BlueJeans meeting from Slack users will be prompted to sign in to their BlueJeans account.

User will be redirected to their Company's Login Page Note: similar experience for HipChat





This would be the Company's branded SSO login page, for example of Acme enterprise.




User is prompted to "allow" Slack to have access to:

User is prompted to return to Slack to initiate meetings using the slash command: /bluejeans






Initiating a BlueJeans meeting within Slack **Slash commands- 3 Options Desktop or Mobile**

1) /bluejeans

This creates a meeting link in Slack using your personal meeting ID



2) /bluejeans meeting name

This creates an ad hoc meeting with a unique meeting ID
